

Debugging

The Visual Basic debugger is a truly advanced tool that can help you identify problems with your program.

Setting and Removing a Break Point

To set a break point, simply click on the gray area to the right of your statement. The statement will be highlighted in brown, and a brown dot will appear beside the statement in the gray area. The Break Point can be set during the design mode by press (F9). The Break Point can be removed by using the same key.

Step Over

This option allows you to execute the current line of code by pressing (F8).

Setting a Watch

To set a watch, select debug then Add Watch to display the Add Watch window to write the required variable to see it is value.
